I Doubt That...I Think I Do

There is a lot more going on with doubt than meets the eye-just like with the iceberg. We doubt God because there are often underlying issues in our hearts:

- Unresolved negative issues from our past
- Mixed motives
- Relational difficulties-current and past
- Pride
- Hidden selfishness
- Stubbornness
- Unfulfilled dreams
- Self-pity
- Financial pressures
- Scheduling pressures

These issues and pressures help make us vulnerable to doubting God...so be aware of them and DEAL WITH THEM!

<u>Doubt</u>: uncertainty of belief or lack of confidence in something.

Sources of doubt:

- Satan—He does this by getting us to question the Word of God
- The world system—it offers "worldly" wisdom to life's problems and questions. It is limited and not of God's wisdom (but don't ever let faith throw away common sense!)
- **Spiritual immaturity**—Pride won't let us admit that sometimes. God tells us that we are often double-minded and full of instability.

Remedies for doubt:

- **Confess** the doubt to God as sin- He has promised to hear you even in your darkest unbelief (<u>Hebrews 11:6</u>)
- **Study** the evidence of the foundational truths of Christ (empty tomb, post resurrection appearances, historical confirmation of Jesus and His life)
- Be assured in your salvation (Hebrews 6:1-20)-have a deep examination of your soul
- Study the Word of God faithfully
- **Pray** for it is the surest way to face doubts when they stare you in the face.
